SEASON 2019



Firstly, welcome to making the first steps to joining the Busselton Football & Sportsman's Club in season 2019. Some of you may have already had a taste of football at the senior club.

1. Age Groups – Currently Year 11/12:

2019 should be the same but we will be notified by SWJFL if this is going to change.

2. If numbers are good we will field 2 sides.

Magpies Black & Magpies White.

3. Transfers from Juniors to Seniors open in November. Please action when you receive your email so as to help the process for registration.

4. Pre- season training starts Jan – Feb please keep an eye out on the club's face book page for details.

5. The club's new website busseltonfootballclub.com.au has information updated regularly.

6. Uniforms – Some clothing is covered in your fees. When pre-season is up and running, we will organise a fitting session and order the required amount of polos and shorts for the teams.

7. Fees have been voted in by the committee and are \$275 for 2019. These have been calculated on the analysis of our 2018 football costs. There will be an initial payment of \$100 on registration, and then a follow up payment is required by Busselton's fourth (4th) playing fixture. Kidsport assistance is available if eligible, and payment plans can be negotiated, if needed.

8. Game day – You are required to wear your club polo, black pants and black shoes to and from the game.

9. Training is Monday & Wednesday - ovals are decided once we know the training capacity for all teams.
10. Weekly selection is based on attendance at training & attitude.
11. Player's code of conduct – just before the season starts we have a player's code of conduct night which is compulsory for all players to attend. A player's tea is provided and the code of conduct is discussed to all attending players. This document is signed by the players and, for those under 18, their parents also sign.
12. Fundraising – we do have fundraising through-out the year and you will be required to participate at some stage. We participate with Bunnings sausage sizzles, Motorfest, Leavers, and the ANZAC Breakfast and Lunch. Our major fundraiser is our \$100 draw where each player in the Year 11/12's, Colts, Women's and Netball teams receive 1 ticket to sell and our Reserves and League receive 2 tickets to sell. This event will be when we play Collie at home (Saturday 20th July).
13. Clubrooms – are open on Friday nights for meals, team announcements, and our monthly Maggies Draw. Game day the bar is open from 12 noon to 12 am on Saturdays and 12 noon to 10pm on Sundays for home games and open on away games after the League game till the licenced closing time.
14. Season for year 11/12's runs for 14 fixtures commencing 4th May with byes in the school holidays. The last Home and Away Fixture is 24th August.
15. Injuries – injured players are still required to attend games and help out if they can.
16. Parent help – There are a few jobs on game day that need to be covered each week. Goal umpiring, boundary umpire, time keeping, trainer etc. If you have any skill set that will assist the team/s please don't hesitate to let us know.

17. Presentation night – is usually held in conjunction with the senior teams however this year we have decided to separate the two. This usually occurs at the beginning of October.

18. Membership – parents are encouraged to become members of the club and we are always actively looking for helpers or new committee members, if this is something that may interest you.

19. AGM – will be scheduled for December. Notices will be put on the Facebook page, Website and advertised via our newsletter. All are welcome.
